

Energy for public supply

STEAG's third foreign power plant is located in the north of the Philippine island of Mindanao. The two-unit power plant produces electricity from hard coal and went into commercial operation on 15 November 2006.

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2003	Start of construction work in December
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2006	Start of commercial operation
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2007	Philippine Aboitiz Power Corp. acquires a 34% stake in the special purpose company; holding a 55% stake, STEAG remains majority shareholder.
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2008	La Philippina Uygongoco Corp. acquires a 15% stake in the special purpose company; holding a 51% stake, STEAG remains majority shareholder.
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
